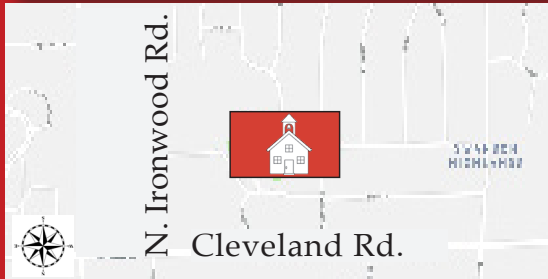

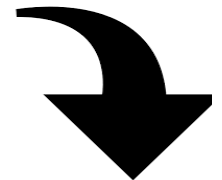
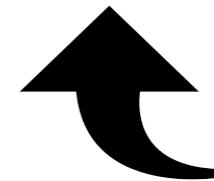

- Parental agreement to a written contract to be actively involved, monitor homework, enforce discipline, and participate in school activities
